Responsibilities:

- Transport and/or assist in transfer of patient to and from gurney.
- Assist in moving patient to and from the courtesy van.
- Apply oxygen to patient and regulate the same.
- Stock and maintain vehicle, keeps contents in a state of readiness at all times.
- Communicate relevant findings/activities of patient to receiving location of service.
- Maintain the van and equipment in clean and sanitary conditions.
- Employ appropriate safety techniques with regard to lifting.
- Working knowledge of gurney and transport chair.
- Full and Part time positions.

Qualifications:

- EMT Certification required
- BLS Training
- Must be willing to work a flexible daytime schedule including weekends
- Prior services in patient transportation (i.e., wheelchair van, ambulance, etc.) preferred.
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Must maintain a clean driving record.
- Proper lifting techniques.
