The collaboration between Niagara Falls Memorial Medical Center's Schoellkopf Health Center and Niagara Hospice brings comfort to seriously ill residents and peace of mind to their families through enhanced services such as:

- Increased nursing and social work visits
- Consultations with specialists in pain and symptom management
- Spiritual care visits
- Massage therapy
- Activities programs
- Pet and music visits
- Tele-visits with family
- Legacy recordings
- Hospice volunteer visits
- Vigil services
- Grief support for family members

Medical Services Include:

Hospice is specialized care for the terminally ill and appropriate for individuals when the prognosis is approximately six months or less to live, if the disease were to run its normal course. Residents who live longer than six months can often continue with hospice care. In most cases, hospice services are covered by Medicare. Fees associated with room and board and/or services provided for care of the resident's unrelated terminal diagnosis will be changed.
