Niagara County residents living in home or an assisted living facility

 Individuals facing serious, progressive illnesses with bothersome symptoms



Comfort Care that focuses on quality of life:

- Education about illness/symptoms
- Assistance with decision making about treatments
- Coordination of health care; navigating the medical system
- Advance directives and planning for the future
- Connection to community resources and assistance with benefit applications
- Coping strategies and emotional/spiritual support for the patient and the caregivers

COPD Congestive heart failure

Cancer and CA treatments Diabetes

Parkinson's Disease Dementia

Loss of appetite Nausea


24/7 telephonic access to a registered nurse
