Where is hospice care provided?

Hospice care is available wherever the patient is most comfortable:

- Patient, family or caregiver homes
- Hospitals, skilled nursing facilities
- Hospice House-Lockport
- David's Path-Niagara Falls
- Jeanne's House-Wheatfield

For individuals who do not have a home environment appropriate for hospice or lack the family to provide 24/7 care at home, Hospice House or a hospice unit at a skilled nursing facility may be the best option to receive the best care possible.

Who can make a referral?

Anyone. Referrals are made by family, friends, clergy, physicians and staff at health care facilities. Patients may call us themselves. We receive as many referrals from family members as we do from hospitals and facilities.

How is hospice paid for?

Hospice is covered under Medicare, Medicaid, most private insurance plans, HMOs and other managed care organizations. No one is denied care due to inability to pay.
